The Roman Republic

Rome became a republic after the expulsion of the Etruscans in 509 BC.

The Roman Republic lasted from 509 BC until the year 27 BC.

Political system

The comitia, senate and magistrates constituted the political institutions of the Roman Republic.

War and expansion

Conquered the whole Italian Peninsula.

Fought three Punic Wars against the Phoenicians.

Conquered Greece and the Eastern Mediterranean and other parts of Europe.

Julius Caesar was assassinated by a group of senators in 44 BC.
